Did You Know? Japanese Traffic Rules & Manners

Pedestrians on the right. Cars and bicycles on the left.

- Pedestrians walk on the right side of the road.
- Pedestrians use sidewalks or pedestrian zones if they are available.
- Cars and bicycles run on the left side of the road.




Wear a helmet regardless of age

60% of cycling fatalities are from head injuries.



Obey traffic lights and road signs.



What to do in the event of a traffic accident.





- ① Stop your bike immediately.
- 2 Move your bike to the roadside. Do not block traffic.
- ③ Call an ambulance (dial 119) if someone is injured. Give emergency aid until the ambulance arrives. However, do not try to move the injured person.

Call the police (dial 110). Never leave the scene of an accident. You are obliged to explain to the police how the accident happened.

Let's review traffic rules & manners for bicycles


Travel on the left side of the road

Violation may be subject to: imprisonment of up

to 3 months or fine of up to 50,000 yen.

As a general rule, bicycles travel on the road.

(Bicycles on sidewalks are allowed only as exceptions to the rule) Violation may be subject to: imprisonment of up to 3 months or fine of up to 50,000 yen. ~Cases where bicycles are allowed on sidewalks~



The Tokyo Metropolitan Government ordinance has been amended, making it mandatory from April 1, 2020 for all those who use bicycles to be insured*.

Take out insurance to cover yourself in case of a bicycle accident.

* Accident insurance for liability coverage in the event of death or bodily injury to a third party caused when using a bicycle
